

Know Your Rights: Human Rights

Everyone has the right to equal treatment under the Ontario Human Rights Code. Under this code everyone has the right to equal opportunity when applying for a job, getting services or renting a home. While this is the law, the reality can be guite different. You may be denied a job or an apartment because of the colour of your skin, your religion, age, or sexual orientation. This unfair treatment can cause pain, humiliation and loss of dignity. Unequal or different treatment that causes harm is called discrimination.
