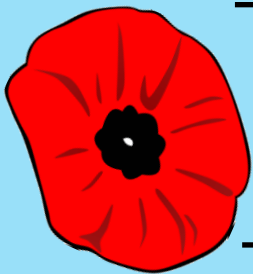

RIGHT OF THE MONTH

Human rights are the basic rights and freedoms afforded to all people. Human rights laws are placed above all others. In Ontario, the Ontario Human Rights Code (OHRC) sets out 17 protected grounds of discrimination in 5 social areas including employment. Here are the 17 grounds as listed in the OHRC:

- Race
- Creed (Religion)
- Age
- Colour
- Receipt of Social Assistance
- Disability
- Ancestry
- Sexual orientation
- Sex (including pregnancy)
- Place of origin
- Marital status (including single)
- Gender Identity
- Citizenship
- Family Status
- Gender Expression
- Ethnic origin
- Record of criminal offenses
