Right of the month: The Right to Unionize!

All workers in Ontario have the right to join a union. In order to do so a union must first demonstrate to the Ontario Labour Relations Board that there is at least 40% support among the workers who will form the bargaining unit. After this a secret ballot vote will be held within 5 days, workers will vote either to unionize or not. Interference, intimidation, and influence by an employer or boss is known as union busting and is strictly prohibited.

Fight for \$15 and Fairness
